History Away Days - 106 Paisley

Paisley has been a royal burgh since 1488, by which time it had been settled for several hundred years. Saint Mirren built a church in the 6th century, replaced around 1163 by Paisley Abbey, the building that still serves as the parish church. From medieval times, the water from the White Cart provided power for mills, and the town was a centre of textile for many centuries; the museum has a superb collection of more than 700 Paisley Shawls.

History Away Days - 114 Falkirk

The town of the 'speckled kirk' was the site of battles in 1298 and in 1746, but during the 18th century the Carron Iron Works started, and produced the cannons that won the battle of Trafalgar - also cooking ranges and grave stones! The flight of locks that joined the Forth & Clyde Canal to the Union Canal and a link to the centre of Edinburgh were removed when navigation ceased, but as part of the Millennium Project a boat lift was installed and through traffic is once again moving between Edinburgh and Glasgow.
