There are a number of different ways to greet someone in Spanish, just as there are in English. A few popular phrases are as follows. You should make a vocabulary list in your jotter. The heading is 'Greetings'.

### Giving your age in Spanish

Tengo in Spanish means 'I have' in English.

In English we say 'I am ....years old' but in Spanish they say 'I HAVE...years'

Write 'tengo' in your jotter and write the meaning in English (I have). Tengo = I have

The 'formula' for giving your age in Spanish is as follows:

Tengo + number + años (e.g. tengo dos años = I am 2 years old).

mi cumpleaños es el (insert figure) de (insert month)  
which means my birthday is the (insert figure) of  
(insert month)

e.g. mi cumpleaños es el cinco de febrero = my  
birthday is the 5th of February.

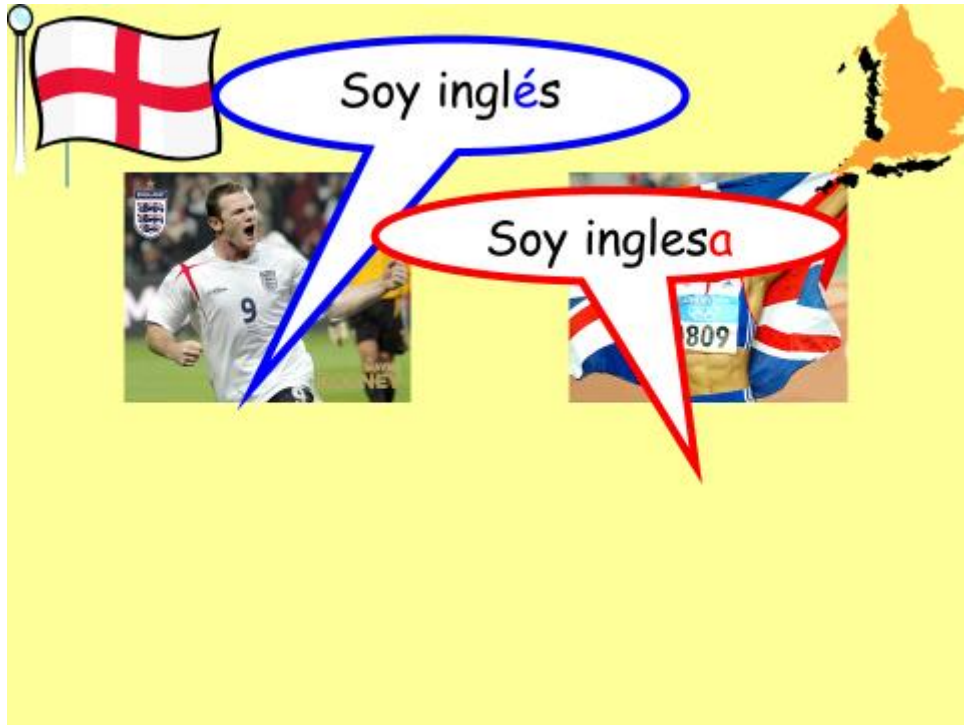
