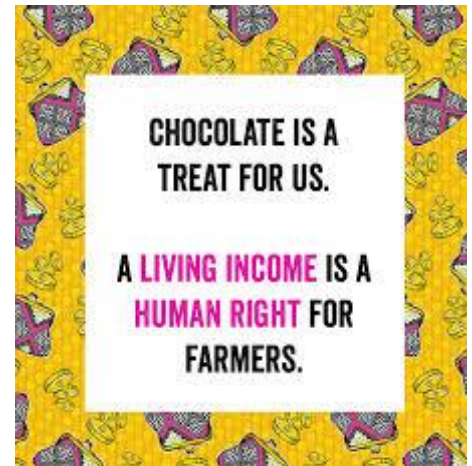

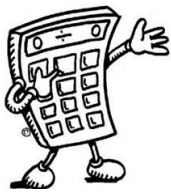

Success Criteria

Ingredients		Equipment
20g	Margarine	• Large bowl
20g	Soft brown sugar (F)	• Plate
$\frac{1}{2}$	Egg (share with your partner)	• Round bladed knife (to crack egg with)
1	Banana (F)	• Electric mixer (1 between 2)
1.25ml	Cinnamon (F)	• Spatula
20g	Wholemeal Self-Raising flour	• Fork
20g	Self-Raising flour	• Mini foil container

## Method

1. Personal preparation.
2. Set oven to 180°C / Gas mark 6.
3. Set out equipment, including foil container, and collect ingredients.
4. On a plate, mash the banana until smooth with a fork.
5. Place margarine, sugar, egg, banana, cinnamon and the flours into a large bowl. Mix with electric mixer until smooth.
6. Fill the foil container with all of the loaf mix.
7. Bake for approx. 15 minutes until well risen and golden brown.

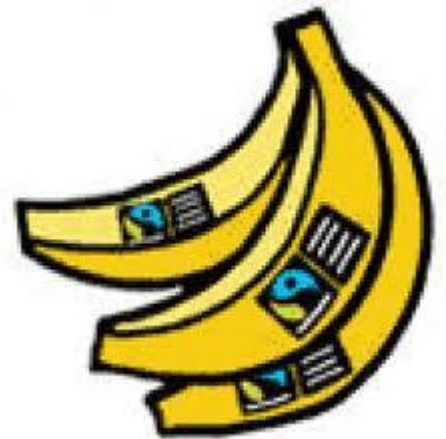
