A **motif** may be repeated in a **pattern** or design, often many times, or may just occur once in a work.

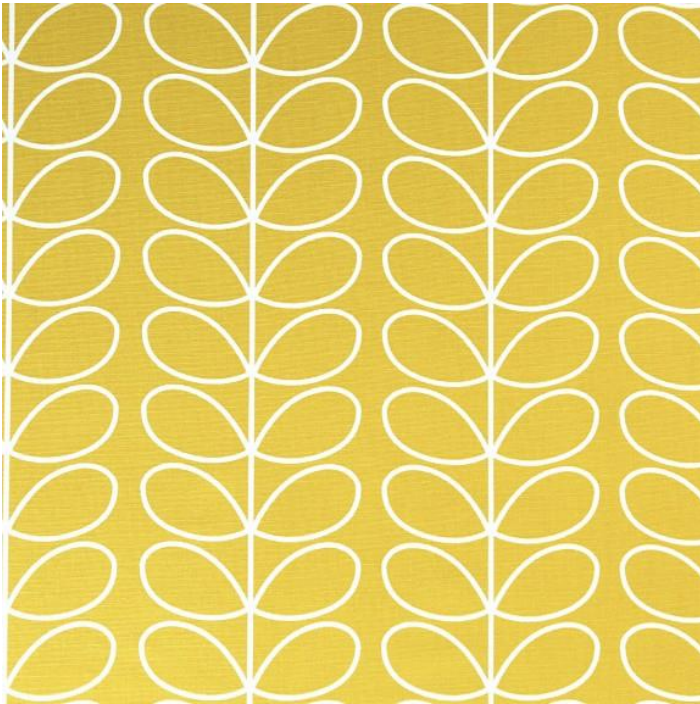
