Lesson Intentions

To review my understanding of Isometric drawings and rendering

Success Criteria

- 1) I Must -- recognise the different techniques used in creating isometric drawings
- 2) I Must -- be able to demonstrate my ability to create isometric drawings
- 3) I Must -- be able to demonstrate my ability to render my 3D drawings.

Activity

On the attached sheet you will find 24 isometric drawing which you already have some experience in creating. Last week you were asked to draw only the first 5 drawings on the sheet. This week I would like you to complete drawing the shapes from number 5 through to number 10 (the second group of five drawings). The drawings cannot be traced and must be at least twice the size shown. How big you draw the object is your choice (don't draw it too big).

When you have completed the drawings, you are asked to render the drawings highlighting the three shade (light, medium and dark). You may render the drawing any colour you wish. The rendering however, must be a colour and not in Gray pencil.
